

План-конспект урока английского языка по теме «eBooks» в 8-м классе

Образовательная цель: совершенствование навыков говорения в рамках темы.


Прогнозируемый результат: предполагается, что к окончанию урока учащиеся смогут прокомментировать плюсы и минусы электронных книг и сделать свой собственный выбор в отношении бумажной или электронной книги.

Сопутствующие задачи:

- совершенствовать умения использовать в устной речи информацию, полученную в ходе восприятия иноязычной речи на слух;
- совершенствовать навыки чтения направленного на общее понимание публицистических и научно-популярных текстов;
- создать условия для активного речевого взаимодействия.

Методы: коммуникативный, интерактивный.

Оборудование урока: интерактивная доска, раздаточный материал, стикеры, клубок ниток, книги, карточки с буквами R, E, G, N и цифрами 1, 4, 9.

1	<p>Организационно мотивационный этап (до 10 минут)</p> <p>Актуализация знаний и целеполагание</p>	<p>Good morning! I'm glad to see you. Are you ready to start our work?</p> <p>I hope we'll enjoy it. But first let's know each other better. I propose you to agree or disagree to some statements (<i>Slide 1</i>). If you agree, you say "I like it", if you disagree – "I dislike it".</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>I prefer going to school.</i> - <i>I enjoy doing shopping.</i> - <i>I am interested in fashion.</i> - <i>I am crazy about computer games.</i> - <i>I am keen on going to the cinema.</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>I am fond of reading.</i> - <i>I go in for sports.</i> - <i>I like quests.</i> <p>Do you know what 'a quest' means? The main idea of quests is to get clues which help to find something special. So today our lesson is a quest and at the end of it we'll try to find something really special in this classroom. During the lesson I'll give you some clues, keys which we'll use later. So the first clue. Please, name something that everyone in this room uses except me. Yes, it is a chair. Touch your chairs. Who has anything under it? So what is it? – <i>a book</i>. And there is a card with the letter R inside. I think we'll need it later. Do you like to read books? What types of books do you prefer? What is your favourite book?</p>	 <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Slide 1</i></p>

Thank you, leave the book here, take your seat.

The second clue is on the screen (*Slide 2*). Look at it. Which word is the odd one? (medicine, drop, pill, tablet, mixture) Yes, you are right, the word “tablet” is not only connected with medicine. Its second meaning is a gadget. Do you see a *tablet* in the classroom? Please, give it to me. Look, there is a card with the letter E on the back. I think we`ll need it later.

Do you have a tablet? Do you use it every day?

So I have a book and a tablet. Please think and say which gadget combines the functions of these two things? (*Slide 3*). Yes, it is eBook.

Do you use eBooks? Is it comfortable to read from the screen?

Do you have many books on your eBook or smartphone?

Now I`d like you to vote. Do you prefer eBooks or traditional paper books? Come here, please, and make a choice. If you are for a paper book, take a red sticker and stick it on the right wing of the blackboard. If you prefer eBooks, take a green sticker and stick it on the left wing of the blackboard. Give arguments and comment on your choice.

Thanks, so some of you prefer gargets, others prefer paper books.

But do you think you know everything about the eBook?

Do you know when it was invented?

Do you understand the difference between paper and electronic books?

Fill in the table.</p> <p>I`d like to check who is the most attentive. When did Google start Google books project? Let`s watch a video and mark the ideas mentioned in it. https://drive.google.com/open?id=0B6oK9VgYKefCLTJwbVkxZlhGUU0</p> <p>What ideas have been mentioned in the video? How many statements are correct? – (4), it is one more clue for our quest.</p> <p><u>eBooks. For and against</u></p> <p>My students work with a blog and I asked them to comment on using eBooks. I`d like you to analyze their comments (<i>Attachment 1, ex.3</i>) and choose positive (group 1) and negative (group 2) ones. Discuss them and add yours. You have 3 minutes.</p> <p>So what are the arguments for eBooks?</p> <p>And what are the arguments for paper books?</p> <p>You have to recharge eBooks every 4-6 hours. 6 minus 4 is two. Look around, are there any two similar things? Yes, windows, come to the window, please. What have you found on a window sill? One more book, give it to me, please. There is a card with the letter N inside and a ball of wool.</p>	
4	<p>Контрольно-оценочный этап (до 10 минут)</p>	<p>Please, stand up and make a circle. I`ll ask you a question, someone answers it, catches a ball, makes a ring around a little finger and throws the ball to a person who is ready to continue. The more rings you have around you little finger the better mark you can get. Is it clear? Let`s start.</p>	

	<p>Развитие речевых умений</p> <p>Подведение итогов урока</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">- <i>Is eBook better than a printed one?</i></p> <p>The wool is over and we have a card with a figure inside, it is one more clue, it is a card with the letter G. Please, count the rings of wool around your fingers. Who has more than three? Great! Take your seats, please. Has anybody changed his or her opinion? Do you want to change your sticker? Thanks. How can you explain your choice?</p> <p>So, our lesson is almost over. Were any tasks difficult for you? Did you like to work in groups? Are you satisfied with your work today?</p> <p>O`k, and now let`s look at our clues. We have cards with letters R, E, G, N and cards with numbers 1, 4, 9. Any ideas?</p> <p>What letter is the 1st in the alphabet? – A, the 4th? – D, the 9th? – I.</p> <p>Can you make a word of these letters? – Yes, READING. I`d like to say, that there is no difference either you are going to read paper books or eBooks, you should read. Reading makes people wise! There are a lot of proverbs about books and reading. By the way, you will work with them at home. You have to look through a list of proverbs about reading at home (<i>Attachment 1, ex.4</i>). Please, choose one you like best and comment on it, be ready to explain why you like this proverb most of all. Is it clear?</p> <p>Great! Some journals became "only" electronic. In 2004 Google launched Google Print, a project of a digital library of 15 million books.
